No person less than 18 years of age shall receive body art without parental consent.

A tattoo should be considered permanent, that it can be removed only with a surgical procedure, and that any effective removal may leave permanent scarring and disfigurement.

Body piercings are not permanent and must be cared for to keep the body piercing functional and free of infection.

Branding should be considered permanent, has a high risk of infection and must be cared for to keep it free of infection.

Consult your physician concerning the dangers of the procedure if you may suffer from certain diseases and/or undergoing certain medical treatments as follows:

1. Impaired kidney and/or liver function;
2. Diabetes;
3. Jaundice within the twelve month period prior to the procedure;
4. Medication therapy containing a blood thinner; and
5. Medication therapies that are immunocompromising (i.e., weakens the immune system that fights infection).

I have been provided written instructions regarding the proper care of the tattooed, pierced or branded skin as a precaution against infections following the body art procedure.

I acknowledge that I have been informed in person and in writing, pursuant to section (2) 20 CSR 2267-5 and Stone County Health Code Body Art Establishment Ordinance.
